WORSHIP MINISTRY PASTORAL STAFF FOR ST. ANDREW'S CATHEDRAL

Saint Andrew's Cathedral is an Anglican cathedral in Singapore which runs approximately 15 services per week. It is located near City Hall, Downtown Core, within the Central Area in Singapore's central business district. It is the main Cathedral church of the Anglican Diocese of Singapore and serves as the mother church of 27 parishes.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

The primary role of a Pastoral Staff in the Worship Ministry is to provide direction and oversight to the entire ministry consisting of the contemporary music teams, choir, audio & visual (AV) team, and the bell ringing team.

- Engage and develop the music teams and AV teams.
- Oversee the development of the choir under the leadership of the choir conductor.
- Oversee the development of the bell ringing ministry.
- Manage the roster and resource platforms for all the groups under the ministry.
- Promote fellowship and spiritual discipleship within the ministry.
- Assume pastoral care of all members serving in the ministry.
- Recruit new members to serve in the ministry.
- Support in the planning of special services e.g. Easter, Christmas etc.
- Oversee the maintenance of musical instruments.
- Plan and steward the worship ministry budget.

REQUIREMENTS

- Possess experience, training and expertise in church music and is able to direct and arrange as needed
- Ability to strategize, organise and communicate ideas well.
- Ability to engage and connect with people, and to work independently and in teams.
- Able to keep abreast of worship developments.
- Able to work on weekends.
- Formal theological training at a minimum of diploma level is preferred.
