The Mission to Seafarers is there for the world's 1.5 million seafarers of all ranks, nationalities and beliefs. Some of the help given to seafarers include spiritual support, transport within Singapore, emergency help and welfare services.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Visit seafarers on board ships at Pasir Panjang Container Terminal, Jurong Port, Anchorage and Tuas Megaport. Pray for seafarers who are open to prayer, share information regarding the port, MtSS drop-in centre, town, etc.
- Visit hospitalized seafarers, pray for those who are open to prayer. Inform and update families and friends regarding the seafarer's health status, support family members in hospital, support seafarers in need.
- Distribute reading materials such as Bibles, international newspapers, MtSS publications, festive goodies.
- Provide transportation for seafarers to city and drop-in centre.
- Refer seafarers in need of support for legal or welfare needs to the relevant authorities.
- Work as a team with the Port Chaplain and other MtSS co-workers for the organizing of special events from time to time.
- Support the MtSS co-workers at the Drop-in Centre when required from time to time.
- Maintain good relationships with partner organizations working with MtSS for seafarer welfare.
- Carry out other duties assigned from time to time by the Port Chaplain or the Management Committee of MtSS.

REQUIREMENTS

- Has a clear sense of calling from God to serve the spiritual and welfare needs of international seafarers as an expression of the Gospel.
- Willing and physically fit enough to work in ports and anchorages.
- Possesses a Class 3 driving license.
- People-oriented, good listener and team player, who is able to work responsibly and independently.
- Willing to work flexible hours
