ASSOCIATE CHAPLAIN FOR ST ANDREW'S NURSING HOME (TAMPINES NORTH)

Chapel of Christ the Redeemer (CCR) is the Anchor Parish for St Andrew's Nursing Home (Tampines North), a service of St Andrew's Mission Hospital (SAMH). SAMH is affiliated historically with the Diocese of Singapore (the Anglican Church in Singapore). As the Anchor Parish, CCR appointed by the Bishop of Singapore to provide pastoral and spiritual care for the beneficiaries and staff of this Nursing Home.

The Associate Chaplain will be employed by the Chapel of Christ the Redeemer (CCR) and deployed to serve full-time at SANH (Tampines North), to provide holistic pastoral and spiritual care for 272 residents, 140 staff members and 40 volunteers. The Home is located at 10 Tampines St 62, and will be operational in 2024.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conduct daily pastoral rounds to assess the well-being of the residents.
- Provide pastoral counseling for residents, family members, staff members or volunteers who have need for it.
- Conduct regular chapel services, devotions, bible studies and/or prayer meetings as the situation permits for residents/staff who wish to attend.
- Recruit, train and support volunteer befrienders to provide more social engagement for residents.
- Coordinate with the Vicar of CCR for the Parish to regularly pray for the Home and express care to residents/staff at special occasions.
- Share skills and knowledge gained from chaplaincy ministry with staff and leaders of CCR to enhance pastoral care for Parish members.
- Collaborate in Multi-disciplinary Care as a team with other care staff in the Home.
- Collaborate with chaplains of other Anglican Nursing Homes in upholding best practices, collegiality and continuing education.

REQUIREMENTS

- Has a calling and passion to minister to the sick and elderly with professional caring skills and the love of Christ.
- Has completed or is undergoing theological studies at a recognized institution at degree level.
- Is able to speak, read, write and present in English, and speak in Mandarin and at least 1 Chinese dialect.
- Competent in office productivity software, e.g., Microsoft Office.
- Has prior experience providing pastoral care, leading worship services, etc., in Christian ministry.
- Open to continuous learning, e.g., medical terminology, procedures, professional caring skills, technology, etc., needed in a Nursing Home.
