ASSOCIATE CHAPLAIN FOR ST ANDREW'S NURSING HOME (TAMAN JURONG)

St Andrew's Mission Hospital (SAMH) /Singapore Anglican Community Services (SACS) are the medical and community service arms of the Diocese of Singapore.

The Chaplaincy Ministry is provided by the Diocese through Anchor Parishes appointed by the Bishop of Singapore to provide pastoral and spiritual care for the beneficiaries and staff of SAMH/SACS Centre.

The Associate Chaplain will be employed by the Anchor Parish, St Andrew's Cathedral, to serve full-time at SANH (Taman Jurong), to provide holistic pastoral and spiritual care for the 300 residents, 140 staff members and 40 volunteers.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conduct daily pastoral rounds for well-being of the residents.
- Provide pastoral counselling for residents, staff members or volunteers.
- Conduct regular chapel.
- Share chaplaincy skills and knowledge

REQUIREMENTS

- Has a calling and passion minister to sick and elderly.
- Completed or undergoing theological studies and recognized institution at degree level.
- Speak English, Mandarin, and 1 dialect
